Before me, T. W. Whatley, a Notary Public & Ex Off. J.P. in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared William Gaiters, who, being first duly sworn, by me, deposes and says as follows: That he has been acquainted with the following lands for more than thirty years, viz: The $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$, $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, and all that part of the west half of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ lying north and east of a line beginning 98 links north of SW corner of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, thence south 82 degrees 15 minutes east 20.52 chains, thence north 16 degrees 45' west, 10.54 chains, thence south 76 degrees 30' west 6.19 chains, thence north 18.75 chains, thence west 11.50 chains to the west line of said section, all in Sec. 24, Tp. 22 S. Range 3 west. Also $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 5, and $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 6, and that part of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ lying south of the Columbiana and Montevallo dirt road, and that part of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ lying north and east of the above described line in Sec. 6 and $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$, $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Tp. 24 N Range 13 east; and that F.
