Whereas, Uriah Grigsby of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Uriah Grigsby according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled Man Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section twelve, in township twenty two, of Range two west, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing forty acres and fifteen and a half hundredths of an acre accrding to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Uriah Grigsby.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Uriah Grigsby and to his heirs, the said tract above described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Uriah Grigsby and to his heirs and assigns forever.
