Polk and Sarah Polk, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One & No/100 Pollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant, to said company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said company over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a part of a tract of Land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

The northeast quarter of southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 21, south, Range 1 west. Said strip is approximately described as follows: Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuations thereof.
