Shelby county, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Freeze according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th day of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the southwest quarter of Section one, and the west half of the northwest quarter of Section Twelve in Township twenty, of Range three west in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa. Alabama, containing two hundred and thirty nine acres, and forty hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tracts have been purchased by the said William Freeze.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said "illiam Freeze and to his heirs, the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said William Freeze and to his heirs and assigns forever.
