M. Hollis the party of the second part the following tract of land to-wit: the SE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section thirty six, township eighteen, range one east. Beginning at the SE corner of said tract of land and north on the line to a branch thence down said branch to a white oak tree thence SE along a hollow to the Section line and thence east along the section line to the beginning corner being six acres more or less lying in the Tuscaloosa land district. Hartsfield and Johnie Hartsfield his wife doth bind themselves their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns and forever warrant and defend all and singular the tenants as well in law as in equity in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this the first day of February, 1881.
