KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that whereas; on 28 day of May, A.D. 1923, the Probate Court of Shelby County rendered a decree for the sale of lands hereinafter described and conveyed for the payment of State and County taxes then due from Mrs. Martha Lee the owner of said lands, and for the payment of the fees, costs and expenses of and under said decree, and the sale had in execution thereof.

And whereas, application has been made to the Auditor of the State by George Huddleston to purchase said lands, and said sum of Fifty & No/100 (\$50.00) Dollars therefor has been paid into the State Treasury.

Now therefore, I, W. B. Allgood, as Auditor of the State of Alabama, by virtue of and in accordance with the provisions of said Chapter 58, Article 8 of the Code of Alabama of 1923, with the approval of the Governor of Alabama, and in consideration of the premises above set out, have this day granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George Huddleston without warranty or covenant of any kind on the part of the State, express or implied, all right and title of the State of Alabama in and to said lands, described as follows:
