

THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this the 14th day of March A.D 1927, by and between D. Lackey of the first part and Mrs. David Lackey of the County of Shelby, and State of Alabama of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said D. Lackey party of the 1st. part for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has this day granted, bargained, sold, alienated, enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, enfeoff and convey to the said Mrs. David Lackey party of the second part all that certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, all of N 1/2 of SE 1/4, except 20 A off the north end, 25 acres off the north end of the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4, also N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 all in Sec. 13, Also SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec. 24, all in T. 19, Range 2 east; And also SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 19, R. 3 east; And 10 acres in T. 19 R. 2 east in Sec. 14, more fully described as follows: Commencing at a corner, cornering with the Hitchcock and Fetal land, thence along the road south 110 yds. thence W. 440 yds, thence north 110 yds, thence east by the sides of Lean and Hitchcocks land to starting point, on the road leading from Vincent to Masters, and all that part or parcel of land in SW corner of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 19, R. 2 east lying south & west of Cen. of Ga. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described tracts or parcels of land, together with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging, or otherwise appertaining unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever. And the said D. Lackey of the first part, for himself, heirs, executors, and administrators does warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the party of the second part her heirs and assigns, from and against themselves, and all and every person claiming or holding under them, the said party of the first part, and against the lawful title, claim or demand of all and every person whomsoever.
