Raley and wife Mrs. Ivy Raley, Walter C.Raley unmarried and Mrs. Lillie Phillips a widow, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Four & No/100 Pollars (\$54.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation the receipt whereof is acknowledged do hereby grant to said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretorore made by said Company, over and across the lands of which itis hereinafer described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on landadjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

The east half of northwest quarter of Section 15, township 19 south, range 2 east. Said strip is approximately described as follows: Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuations thereof; Commence at a point on north boundary of said section 15, said point being east 1247.2 feet from the northwest corner of said section 15, thence run south 23 degrees 27 minutes east 170.7 feet to a point; This is the point of beginning: From said point of beginning run south 23 degrees 27 minutes east 2673.7 feet more or less to line dividing lands of grantors and J. E. Harris.

To have and to hold the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which said company may from time to time exercise hereunder.
