TRANSMISSION LINE PERMIT

We, G. Buckelew and wife Willie Buckelew for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy Five and $N_0/100$ Dollars (\$75.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power ompany accorporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said company, over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment of use thereof for the purposes above described including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 11, Township 18 south, range 1 east. Said strip is approximately described as follows: Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuations therof; beginning at a point on the west boundary of said section 11, south 1591.5 feet from the northwest corner of said section 11, thence south 50 degrees 12 minutes east for a distance of 1643.7 feet to a point on the south boundary of said southwest quarter of northwest quarter Section 11.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said company, its successors and assigns forever. The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which the grantee may from time to time exercise hereunder.
