Shaw former house place to Union church in section 32, Township 19, Range I East. Also a part of the north east quarter of the south east quarter of section 31, (NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄) beginning at the north east corner of said quarter section and running 210 yards south; thence west to Spring branch; thence up said branch to quarter section line; thence east along said line to starting point. And a part of the south east quarter of the north east quarter (SE¹/₄ of NE¹/₄) section 31; Beginning on the public road at the east corner of the former J. E. Adams house yard fence and running thence 70 yards north; thence 70 yards west; thence 70 yards south; thence 70 yards East to starting point, in Township 19, Range I East.
