Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 51286 for 40 acres, issued in favor of Gillis I. Adams Private in Captain Pari's Company, Alabama Volunteers Florida War has been returned to the General Land Office with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section Thirty in Township Eighteen of Range Two east in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Forty acres and two and three fourths hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which has been assigned to James W. White

Now Know Ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said James W. White the tract of land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said James W. White and to his heirs and assigns forever.

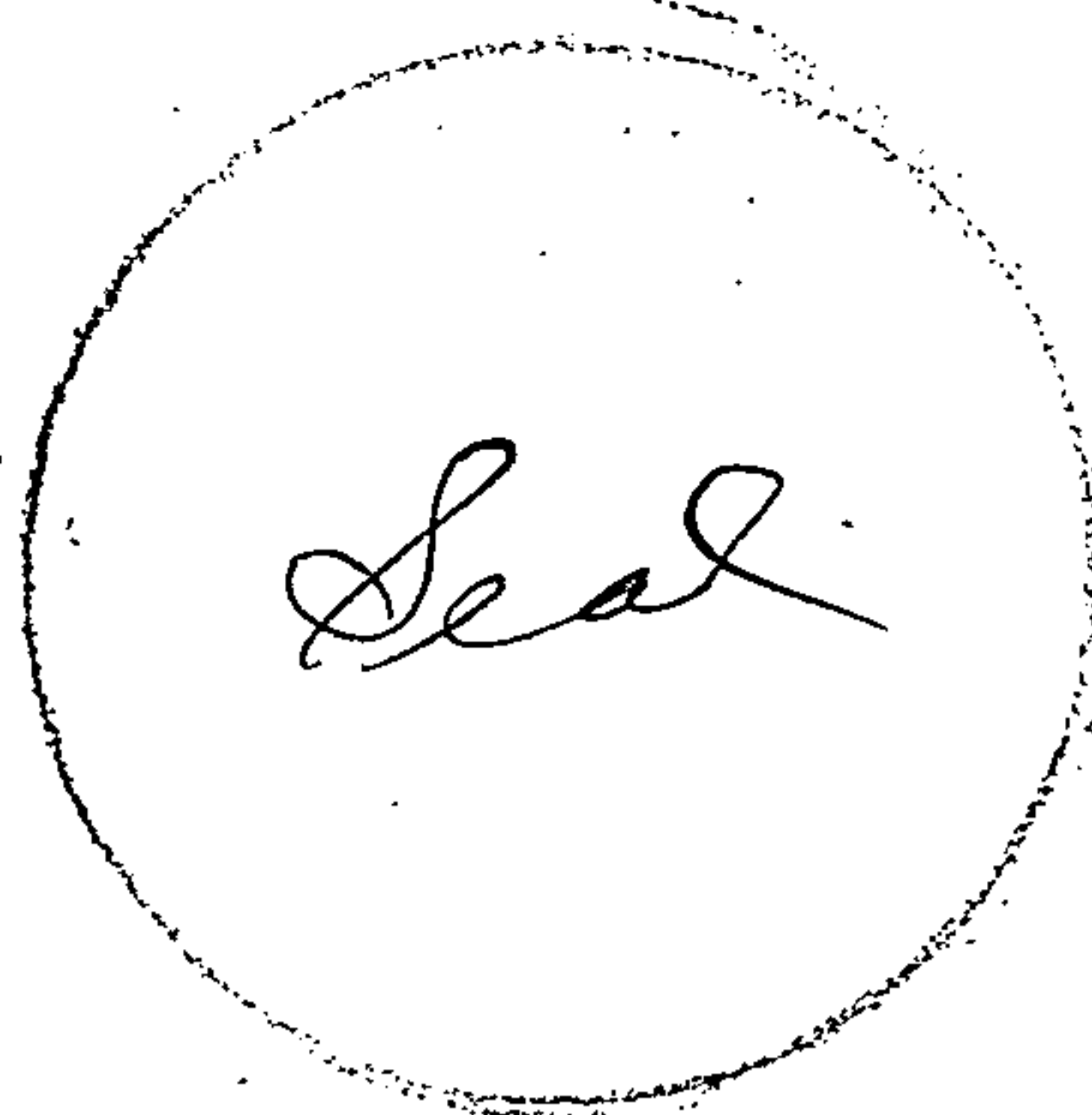
In testimony whereof I Millard Fillmore President of the United States of America have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
