Douglas single of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of (\$295.00) in handpaid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said "helby County, its successors or assigns, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the Lands of the undersigned for a public road: Which right of way shall be 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked by the Engineer designated as Montgomery Highway our lands as is required to make a 50 foot right of way across our lands which said right of way is described as follows: Piece No. 1, beginning at a point at the center of Peavine Creek distant 50 feet westerly from the centerline at Station N_0 . 882x40 of the New Montgomery Highway. Running thence north 4 degrees 29 minutes east for 176.5 feet to the A. B. & A. R.R. right of way. Then easterly along said right of way line 101.4 feet, then south 4 degrees 29 minutes west for 143.5 feet to center of Peavine Creek, then westerly 100 feet along center of said creek to point of beginning. Above piece is located in SWA of NWA Sec. 24, Township 20 S. R. 3 W and contains 0.32 acres.

Piece No. 2. Beginning at a point on the north edge of the A. B. & A. right of way distant 50 feet west at right angles from station No. 885x17.9 of the New Montgomery Highway center line. Extending thence north 4 degrees 29 minutes east for 286.2 feet to the line dividing the $SW_{4}^{1} - NW_{4}^{1}$ and $NW_{4}^{1} - NW_{4}^{1}$, then east along said line for 100.3 feet, then south 4 degrees 29 minutes west for 327 feet to the A. B. & A. right of way.
