We hereby agree that all agreements and contracts heretofore executed by us to him personally or as executor shall remain in full force and effect to him as "Agent for the Mallory Estates" and that with regard to all of the property inherited by or devised or bequeathed to us under said wills, together with all accumulations thereof and reinvestments thereof, he shall have the same power, rights and authority as such agent as he had as executor of saidnamed wills, and as such agent he shall also have the same rights, powers and authority as he would have had under any and all agreements heretofore made with him individually or as such executor, the same to extend until January 1st, 1927, and thereafter until one of us shall express a desire to have same terminated, and as said agent he shall also be entitled to all privileges and emoluments he would have had as Executor or individually under any such agreements.

This agreement and power is irrevocable prior to January 1st, 1927, and thereafter only by death or written revocation. properly executed and recorded in the Probate Office of Dallas County, Alabam a. Heis also authorized, out of funds coming into his hands as such agent to pay any obligations of said estates or that may have been incurred by him as Executor of either. He is also authorized to handle all of our joint funds and securities as he may see fit, and make sales, grant releases and execute satisfactions and authorize others to do so. In the matter of securities in the name of our Father or Mother or in his name as Executor that he may deal with either by way of sale or otherwise, he may conduct such transaction either under the title of executor or as said agent, as he may see fit, and in whichever way he does it his acts shall be equally binding on us and are hereby ratified.

All agreements now existing between us, or either of us, and said Hugh Mallory either personally or as executor, shall remain in full force.
