KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

WHEREAS, the main track of the railroad of Southern Railway Company running between Birmingham and Wilton crosses a branch or stream by means of a trestle about one hundred eighty (180) feet in length, at a point one hundred ninety three and five-tenths (193.5) feet east of milepost 14-R at or near Superior in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section fourteen, township twenty one south, range four west (NW2 of SW2 of Sec. 14, Tp. 21, S. R. 4 W) Shelby County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, said Railway Company proposes to fill the said trestle, and for such purpose will require a strip of land thirty (30) feet in width on each side of the present right of way which is fifty (15) feet on each side of the center line of said main track, that is to say, will require for the purposes of the embankment to be created in the filling of said trestle, a right of way eighty (80) feet on each side of the center line of said track, for a distance of about ninety (90) feet on each side of the said creek, or for a total distance measured by the length of the said trestle; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Julian E. Dow, is the owner of the property lying on either side of the railroad and present right of way, and is willing that the said trestle may be filled, and the said embankment created thereby may extend over and beyond the limits of present right of way, and may occupy a strip thirty (30) feet in width on each side of present right of way opposite said trestle as aforesaid;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to him in hand paid by the grantee hereinafter named, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Julian E.Dow, of the County of and State aforesaid, has granted, and hereby does grant unto Southern Railway Company, and to its successors and assigns:

The right to construct said fill in such manner that the earth and material

used therein may slope over and occupy the land of the said grantor on either side of the present right of way for said railroad, to the extent hereinbefore mentioned and recited; TOGETHER WITH the right to Southern Railway Company to change the said branch or stream on the said land of the grantor in such manner that the water thereof may be conducted across the railroad and right of way, and under the said embankment in a straight line, by means of an eighty four (84) inch by eighty nine (89) inch concrete pipe culvert across said present right of way and property and a ditch to be excavated and maintained by the Railway Company, to extend from the end of said culvert southwardly for a distance of one hundred (100) feet more or less to Piney Woods Creek.
