NOW KNOW YE that the United States of America inconsideration of the premises and in conformity with the several actsof Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Acton and his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging unto the said John Acton and to his heirs and assigns forever.
