Before me, the undersigned authority, this day personally appeared Frank Miller, who being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows to-wit: That he is fifty two years of age; that he knows of his own personal knowledge that at the time Benjamin Reed and his wife, Elizabeth Reed, made a deed to Thomas B. Miller on December 31, 1889, conveying the east half of the southeast quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 30, Township 19, Range 2 west in Shelby County, Alabama, the said lands constituted no part of the homestead of the grantors or either of them; that affiant also knows of his own personal knowledge that at the time Stephen A. D. McGuire and his wife, Ada F. McGuire, conveyed to said Thomas B. Miller, the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 19, Range 2 west, in Shelby County, Alabama, on January 13, 1896, the said lands constituted no part of the homestead of said grantors, or either of them; that the said grantors in said last mentioned deed lived at Pelham, Alabama, at the time of said conveyance.
