- (3) That affiant helped cut timber for fences, posts, rails and fire wood near the northwest corner of the Johnson place, the forty which is located in the extreme northwest corner and which affiant is informed is the southwest quarter of southeast quarter of Section 33, Township 18 south of Range 2 west;
- (4) Affiant knows of his own personal knowledge that J. D. Maske was holding all of said lands for Isaac W. Johnson during his life time and for his children after his death between the years 1893 and 1901 as a renter and that he paid rent to Johnson during his life time and to his children after his death, during said period of about eight years;
- of said place during about 35 years last past and that said possession has been by Isaac W. Johnson's tenant, J. D. Maske, and since he gave up the place, by Theo W. Johnson and J. M.C. Johnson, children of the said Isaac W.
