On 20th day of September 1899 I sold to Jonas Schwab Company, 100 acres land in Shelby County, known at the time as the "Nichol's Place" Which land was purchased by me from said Nichol's, and in making transfer of said place an error was made in deeding 20 acres of said land from the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of S.W. $\frac{3}{4}$, of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 17, Range 1E, to the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, of said Section causing the land to be erroneously conveyed.

The lands rightfully conveyed as the "Nichols Place" has been in undisputed possession by Jonas Schwab Company ever since and is known today as the Schwab Lands, and the taxes have been rightfully paid ever since.
