Blan as Auditor of the State of Alabama, by virtue of and in accordance with the provisions of said Chapter 58, Article 8, of the Code of Alabama of 1923, with the approval of the Governor of Alabama, and in consideration of the premises above set out, have this day granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said George Huddleston, without warranty or covenant of any kind on the part of the State, express or implied, all right and title of the State of Alabama in and to said lands, described as follows NW2, Section 8, Township 19, Range IW., lying and being situate in said County and State, to have and to hold the same, the said right and ntitle of the State in the land aforesaid, unto George Huddleston and his heirs and assigns forever.
