

## Power Of Attorney.

In consideration of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in hand paid The First National Bank of Greensboro, a corporation, by Dr.C.O. Lawrence, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, The First National Bank of Greensboro, a corporation, ~~do~~ hereby release Dr. C.O. Lawrence from any and all liability on that certain judgment rendered in its favor in the Circuit Court of Hale County, Alabama, on October 23, 1924, against J.B. Abernathy and Dr.C.O. Lawrence, for Four Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Nine and 86/100 Dollars (\$4,329.86) and Fifteen and 55/100 Dollars (415.55) court costs, the amount being paid The First National Bank of Greensboro by Dr. C.O. Lawrence being a full discharge of and release to Dr. C.O. Lawrence; but it is understood and agreed that J.B. Abernathy is not released or discharged and the balance due on said judgment and costs still remains in full force and effect against J.B. Abernathy.

The First National Bank of Greensboro hereby constitutes and appoints L.H. Ellis of Columbiana, Alabama, its true and lawful agent and attorney in fact to enter on the record of the certificate of judgment, recorded in Judgment Record C, Page 223, of Shelby County Probate Office, the following release and discharged:

"In consideration of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) paid to it by Dr.C.O. Lawrence this judgment is released against Dr. C.O. Lawrence, and the lien thereof against him is satisfied and discharged in full, and The First National Bank of Greensboro no longer holds any claim against Dr. C.O. Lawrence on said judgment nor any lien based on this certificate thereof; but the balance due under said judgment is still due from J.B. Abernathy and he is not released nor discharged by this settlement with Dr.C.O. Lawrence.
