TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING: Whereas, John Foust of Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John Foust according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the public lands", for the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 26, and the south half of the northeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, the north half of the southeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section twenty seven in township twenty one, of range three west in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing three hundred and nineteen acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said John Foust.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided HAVE GIVE AND GRANTED and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT unto the said John Foust and to his heirs said tracts above described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said John Foust and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
