A certain lot situated in the town of Montevallo, Shelby County Alabama, described as follows. Commencing at a point on the South west side of middle street one hundred and twenty five feet south east from the northermost corner of block 47) thence south east along the margin of middle street one hundred and seventy eight feet more or less or to the eastermost corner of said block 47) thence south west along the north west side of Alabama street one hundred and fifty feet to the eastermost corner of the Presbyterian Church lot, thence north west perpendicular to Alabama street seventy eight feet thence parallel with Alabama street twenty eight feet thence north west parallel with middle street one hundred and two feet more or less to the corner of the Ed.
