TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING: Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th 1850 entitled "An Act granting Bounty to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 37194 for 80 acres issued in favor of George Harris, Private in Captain Chisholm's Company. Tennessee Militia, Seminole War has been returned to the General Land Office with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the north half of the southwest quarter of Section twenty four in Township Twenty one of Range One west in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing seventy nine acres and seventy two hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor General, which has been assigned to Eudson W. Nelson.

Now know ye, that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Hudson W.Nelson, the tract of land above described. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances there of unto the said Hudson W. Nelson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce, President of the United States of merica, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
