Oliver, who having been first duly sworn deposes and states as follows, viz: I am now a resident of Shelby County Alabama and am the widow of the Henry L. Oliver who died at or near Calera Alabama, in Shelby County on or about June 1894. That affiant Hannah L. Oliver, the widow and the following children Herndon A. Oliver Sr. George C. Oliver, and Arthur A. Oliver are the only heirs of the said Henry L. Oliver and that all of the said heirs are over the age of twenty one years. That there has been no administration upon the estate of the said Henry L. Oliver, and that there are no unpaid or outstanding debts or claims against the estate of the said Henry L. Oliver. That my husband was the same Henry L. Oliver to whom a mortgage was given by Perry Sams and his wife dated June 6th 1893 and recorded in Volume 35 on page 26 of the mortgage records of Shelby County, Alabama. That the said mortgage was foreclosed and the property sold in front of Wright's Drug Store at Calera, Alabama on August 25th 1893, and at said sale my said husband Henry L. Oliver was the highest/bidder and the property was sold to him and thereupon he went into possession of the said property and exercised ownership and control thereof.
