Mathis of the second part, witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, the following described land lying in Shelby County the State of Alabama to-wit: east half of the north east fourth, and southwest fourth of northeast fourth of Section No. 14 in Township No. 20 of Range No. 2 west. To have and to hold to the said second party, their heirs and assigns forever, the above described and hereby granted lands and premises; And the said parties of the first part, husband and wife, hereby covenant with the said party of the second part that they are lawfully seized of and have a good right to sell and convey said land and hereby bind themselves, their heirs and legal representatives forever, to warrant and defend the title to said land and premises to the said party of the second part, their heirs, assigns and legal representatives, against the claim of all and every person, in law or equity, and against the government of the United States.
