

AFFIDAVIT

Before me L.H.Ellis, a Notary Public in and for Shelby County Alabama, personally appeared W. M.Farr who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says that he is acquainted with the following land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz: the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 20, Range 1 west; that he is the son of David Farr, who was grantee in that certain deed executed by Blanton Moore on the 14th day of October, 1878, and which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 41 at page 237. Further deposing, affiant says that said David Farr went into possession of the hereinabove described land on the date of the execution of the aforementioned deed and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession of said land until he sold and deeded it to affiant on the 31st day of December, 1891, and which deed from David Orr to affiant is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County Alabama, in Deed Book 41 at page 238. Further deposing, affiant says that he went into possession of said land immediately after the execution of the aforementioned deed to him and remained in the actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive adverse possession of same down to the time he sold and deeded the same to the First National Bank of Birmingham, Alabama on the 4th day of January, 1922, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 70 at page 387. Further deposing, affiant says that from the year 1878 to the time he deeded said land to the First National Bank of Birmingham, Alabama, no person, firm or corporation advanced any claim to the same adverse or antagonistic to his claim thereto or to the claim of his father, David. Farr. Further deposing, affiant says that from the time his father David Farr, procured the aforementioned deed down to the time affiant deeded the land to the First National Bank of Birmingham, he, or his father, one or the other, lived on said land continuously except for the last five or six years prior to the date of affiant's deed to said First National Bank of Birmingham, Alabama.
