Gleen in hand paid by Mrs. Dellaler Gleen the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Mrs. Dellaler Gleen all his right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, towit:

Begin at a point four hundred forty (440) feet West of the Northeast corner of Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter. (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3) Township (24) Range 13 East, and run Thence due West four hundred forty (440) feet, Thence South two thousand six hundred forty (2640) feet, Thence East four hundred forty (440) feet. Thence North two thousand six hundred forty (2640) feet to point of beginning, being the middle one third (1/3) of the Southeast quarter of Northeast (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 3, Township 24, Range 13 East, and containing twenty six and 2/3 acres, more or less.
