Application 7963) Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery Alabama, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John T. Cromwell Junior has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South half of the south west quarter the north east quarter of the south west quarter and the south east quarter of the north west quarter of section twenty two in township twenty south of range one west of Huntsville Meridian in Alabama. Containing one hundred and sixty acres, and thirty two hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States, unto the said John T. Cromwell Junior the tract of Land above described: To Have And To Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John T. Cromwell Junior and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
