Before me the undersigned authority in and for said County and State, personally appeared Jim Lee, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he knew James Cost in his life time and knows that when he died, he left the following children and they were all the children he had namely, A.W. Cost, Harriet Cost Powers, Ollie Cost and Mary S. Cost; that soon after the death of James Cost, the above named children met in the store of Mr. Oates, at Pelham, Ala. and made deeds to each other, to various tracts of lands. Affiant avers that he was present, when these deeds were made, and saw A. W. Cost and wife Sallie E. Cost, and O. Cost and Mary S. Cost make a deed to Harriett C. Powers, and husband William C. Powers, to all their interest, in and to the following lands, which said lands belonged to James Cost, at his death, viz: the south half of the northeast fourth, of Sec. 24, Tp. 20, south of range 3 west, Affiant avers that he was present and saw the deeds above referred to, executed and acknowledged and that they were acknowledged before W. C. Denson, a Justice of the Peace, and that William C. Oates, and C. C. O'Barr and that they are now dead, were the subscribing witnesses to the deeds. That the above deeds, were executed, signed and delivered, on or about the 1st. day of Feby. 1904, and that the parties went into possession of the tracts of lands that was deeded to them immediately, affiant further avers, nothing more.
