

AFFIDAVIT

This is to certify that in the year of 1905 I was Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and that on June 12th 1905, a decree was rendered by the Probate Court of said County, Alabama for the sale of lands hereinafter described for the State and County taxes due from Margurate C. Steel, the owner of said lands, and whereas on the 17th day of June, 1905 said lands were duly sold by the Tax Collector of said County for said taxes, costs and expenses, and that T.W. Johnson became the purchaser of said lands, described as follows: S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 19, Range 2 west and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 19, Range 2 west, surface right, all of said lands being in Shelby County, Alabama, and a deed was made on July 18, 1907 to said T.W. Johnson to said lands, and the same was duly recorded on the 22nd day of November, 1907 in the records of Deeds in said County, and in recording the said deed the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 19, Range 2 west, was by mistake left off the record.
