Personally appeared before me the undersigned authority J. K. Brockman, who being by me duly sworn on oath says: that he has acted as agent and attorney for Keystone Lime Company for more than twenty years last past; that during the whole of said period affiant has had charge and general control of the lands of the Keystone Lime Company, described as follows:

Group One

West half $(\mathbb{W}_{2}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of southwest quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{W}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$, southeast quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{W}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of southeast quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{W}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of southeast quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{E}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ and that part of the southeast quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{E}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of southeast quarter $(\mathbb{S}\mathbb{E}_{4}^{\frac{1}{2}})$ lying west of Buck Creek in Section twenty three (23),

The northwest quarter $(NW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ the west half $(W_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the northeast quarter $(NE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ the north half $(N_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the northwest quarter $(NW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of the southeast quarter $(SE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ and east half $(E_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section twenty six (26)

The north half $(N_{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the northeast quarter $(NE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of northwest quarter $(NW_{\frac{1}{4}})$, northeast quarter $(NE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$, southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of southwest quarter $(SW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ and northwest quarter $(NW_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of southeast quarter $(SE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section twenty nine (29),

The east half (E_2^1) of the northeast quarter (NE_4^1) and the south half (S_2^1) of Section thirty one (31), all being in Township twenty (20), Range two (2) west, excepting the mineral interests and mining rights and privileges not owned by said Keystone Lime Company.

That the lands described in Group One have well defined buildings upon them

Lime Company has been paying the taxes thereon for more than twenty years last past; that the lands described in Group Two have a dwelling and a portion thereof has been cultivated, the same being occupied by a tenant of the Keystone Lime Company for more than twenty years last past; that the lands described inGroup Three have been held as timber lands; that during said period of twenty years last past the Keystone Lime Company has cut timber therefrom and used the same in connection with a lime industry which it formerly owned; that it has leased and sold the timber rights therein to various persons and has since re-acquired all outstanding timber interests and leaseholds of said timber, and that during the whole of said period said Keystone Lime Company has had its agents in charge of said timber lands, has a care taker for general supervision and has been paying the taxes thereon since the time of its purchase, more than twenty years last past.

Affiant further says that during the whole of said period of twenty years last past no person has asserted any title, claim of title, or right of title in or to any portion of said lands adversely to the said Keystone Lime Company; that its possession and ownership has been open, notorious, undisputed, claiming to own the same and being inactual, physical possession thereof, and affiant says that if any such claim had been made by any person adverse to said Keystone Lime Company, he would have been the proper person to take notice thereof and to resist any such claim.
