Personally appeared before me the undersigned authority in and for said County and State, J.W.Roy, who being duly sworn on oath states that he personally knows Mary L. Braswell whose maiden name was Mary Roy, and who is otherwise sometimes called Mollie L. Braswell, and that said Mary L. Braswell is his aunt. Affiant knows that said Mary L. Braswell was the daughter of Malden Roy, who was affiant's grandfather. Mary Roy married Tom Braswell, who has been dead something like thirty years and she is now a widow and hasnot remarried.

Affiant is thoroughly familiar with the property described as the "NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 20, Range 3 west, situated in Shelby County, Alabama", conveyed by his grandfather Malden Roy and wife to his aunt Mary Roy, now Mary Braswell, having known the land in question all his life, and is thoroughly familiar with the possession of said land from the time his said grandfather conveyed it to said Mary Roy, now Mary Braswell. Said Mary Roy took pisseession of all of said land at the time it was conveyed to her in 1883 and assessed same and paid taxes onnsame and kept a large part of same under cultivation and she assessed and paid taxes on that part of said tract of land situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 20, Range 3 west, and was in possession of same, and to affiant's certain knowledge has sold timber off of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11, on two separate occasions at least, and has claimed to own all of said tract of land including said S $\frac{1}{2}$ of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 11, continuously from the time same was deeded to her by said Malden Roy, sand has been in open, notorious adverse exclusive and continuous possession of all of said tract of land including said S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 20, Range 3 west, ever since same was deeded to her by Malden Roy in 1883, and for more than forty years last past.
