Before me J. W. Gillon Jr. a Notary Public in and for said County and State, first personally appeared Ricker Benton, who is known to me and who being by me duly sworn, deposes and says that he is the son of W. C. Benton, deceased, who died a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, and that in the proceedings in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama, the following were shown as the heirs of W.C. Benton, to-wit: Mack Benton, Jesse Benton, T.J. Letson, Mrs. J. T. Letson, Ryan McClendon, Mrs. W. C. Benton, Jane Dickenson, Verlie Benton, Velma Benton, Elma Benton, J.M. Benton, and Ricker Benton; that the Mack Benton referred to in said proceedings is the same as M.D. Benton, and the Jesse Benton referred to in said proceedings is the same as J.W. Benton who sometimes signs his name Jesse W. Benton, and that the T. J. Letson there referred to is a clerical error, as it was intended to describe Mrs. Cora Letson, and that the Mrs. J.T. Letson is a clerical error, as it was intended to name Mrs. J.W. Letson; that the said Mrs. Cora Letson and Mrs. J.W. Letson were formerly known as Cora Benton and Eugenia Benton before their marriage; that Ryan McClendon is the same as R. H. McClendon, and that Mrs. W. C. Benton is Emma Benton, who was the widow of the decedent; that Jane Dickenson has since married and is now known as Jane Benton Griffin; that the Velma Benton there referred to is a clerical error and should be written Ulma Benton and that the Elma Benton there referred to is a clerical error and should have been written Elmore Benton, and that all of the above parties joined in executing a deed to R. W. Kent under date of November 1st, 1928, conveying certain property in Shelby County, Alabama; that the said Emma Benton, Eugenia Letson, J. M. Benton, Effie C. McClendon, Mrs. Cora Letson, Jesse W. Benton, M. D. Benton, E. F. Benton, Janie Benton Griffin, Verlie Benton Atchison, Ricker Benton and Ulma Lee Benton are the only heirs at law of W.C. Benton; that Emma Benton was the widow of W. C. Benton, and the others named were his children who survived him; that the said W.C. Benton left no other child surviving him and no children of a deceased child, and further affiant saith not.
