

AFFIDAVIT

Before me J.D.Ruffin a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, personally appeared Mary L. Thompson, who being duly sworn deposes and says that she is the same person who conveyed certain lands to Charles M. Roy on the 22nd day of December 1893, which said lands are described as follows:

Also the following described piece of land: Commence at the conglomerate boulder near the large hickory stump, thence due south to a cedar stake at corner of the Thompson potato patch, thence easterly veering a little northward to a cedar stake on the top of the old Harmony Church ridge, thence northerly along the top of the ridge to the John G. Jones wagon road to the conglomerate boulder at the point of commencement, containing 3 acres, more or less in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further states that said lands above conveyed by me are one and the same lands but more particularly and definitely described in a deed of L.N. Roy and wife to M.E. Roy dated November 18, 1922, said description in said deed being as follows:

A tract of land known as the L. N. Roy homestead, described as follows: Commence at the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 20, Range 3 west, thence east along section line 660 feet to lane between Roy and Riddle lands, thence north 2 degrees west along said lane 1984 feet, thence west 26 degs. north 341 feet to a stake, thence 3 degs. and 30 min. north 275 feet to stake on top of hill, thence south 2 degs. 15 min. east 208 feet, thence west 30 degs. north along wire fence 208 feet, thence north 9 degs. west 451 feet to white oak on side of road, thence NW along road 160 feet to Hillsboro Branch, thence in a southwesterly direction along said branch to section line, thence east along section line to point of beginning, in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further states that the first deed above referred to described said lands by land marks and the last deed referred to describes the same after definite measurements and survey, but the last said description embraces and includes in to to the lands described in said first deed referred to in this affidavit.
