Richards of Shelty County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Alexander R. Richards according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "AnAct making further provision for the sale of the public lands", for the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section one, and the west half of the northwest quarter of Section twelve inTownship twenty one, of Range three, west in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing one hundred and nineteen acres, and eighty eight and a half hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tracts have been purchased by the said Alexander R. Richards.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVENAND GRANTED and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Alexander R. Richards and to his heits, the said tracts above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Alexander R. Richards and to his heirs and assigns forever.
