## RIGHT OF WAY DEED

Jackson and wife Drue Moss Jackson of the county and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelty County, thereceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands we do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelty County, its successors or assigns, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the lands of the undersigned in Shelby County, Ala., for a public road; which right of way shallbe 66 feet in width or 33 feet in width on each side of the center line of the said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department or as much of our lands as is required to make a 66 foot right of way, across our lands which are located and described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at Sta. 230 \( \neq 35 \) of State Proj. 330 and running in a NE direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 710 to Sta. 237 \( \neq 45 \). Also beginning at Sta. 239 \( \neq 80 \) of State Proj. 330 and running in a NE direction along center line of said survey for a distance of 380 to Sta. 243 \( \neq 60 \). (Said right of way so conveyed will not cause to be removed more than one shade tree infront of residence) and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
