To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, a certificate of the Assistant Commissioner has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the claimant, Andrew Jackson Brasher, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of April 24, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the public lands", and the acts supplemental thereto, for the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section twenty six in Township nineteen south of Range two west of the Huntsville Meridian Alabama, containing thirty nine acres and ninety two hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, on file in the General Land Office:

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenance of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever.

In testimony whereof, I Calvin Coolidge, President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
