

AFFIDAVIT

Before me L. H. Ellis, a Notary Public in and for Shelby County, Alabama, personally appeared J.T. Davis who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he was acquainted with King H. Davis who on January 14th 1896, received a Patent from the United States Government to the southwest quarter of Section 26, Township 19, Range 1 east, Shelby County, Alabama.

Further deposing affiant says that said King H. Davis has been dead about 18 years, and left surviving him his widow, Martha Davis, who died about two years after he did. Further deposing affiant says that King H. Davis left surviving him the following children, viz:

- a. John Davis
- b. Mollie Davis Thomas
- c. Narcissa Davis Thomas

Further deposing affiant says that said John Davis died about 15 years ago and left surviving him his widow, Nancy Davis, who died about ten years ago, and said John Davis left surviving him three children as follows:

- aa. Andrew Davis, who is over 21 years of age and resides in Talladega Alabama.
- bb. Lizzie Davis Goodwin, who is over 21 years of age and resides at Anniston Alabama.
- cc. Mandy Davis Bates, who is over 21 years of age and resides at Anniston Alabama.

Further deposing affiant says that he is acquainted with Emanuel Salser who on March 16, 1910 executed to J. H. Gardner a deed to the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 19, Range 1 east, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 45 at page 54, and said Emanuel Salser is the same person as M. V. B. Salser, who executed a mortgage to Turner Brothers on said land on March the 9th 1908, which mortgage is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Book 80 at page 522, and is the same person as Emanuel Salser and E. Salser, who received deed from K. H. Davis respectively on July 8, 1902 and August the 5th 1902 conveying respectively, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 19, Range 1 east, Shelby County Alabama, and which deeds are respectively recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 35 at page 524 and deed book 45 at page 52.
