

## AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA )

Before me L. H. Ellis, a Notary Public in and for Shelby County, Alabama, personally appeared James E. Horton who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he was acquainted with Charles C. Wilson, who in April 1913, deeded to Columbiana Ice, Light & Power Company, a certain lot or parcel of land lying and being in the town of Columbiana, Alabama, and being more fully described as follows, to-wit:

A certain lot or parcel of land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, Tp. 21, Range 1 west, and being more particularly described in deed book 53 at page 12 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, where said deed above referred to is recorded.

Further deposing affiant says that said Charles C. Wilson was <sup>also</sup> called Charles Wilson, but whether said Charles Wilson was married on November 10th, 1890, affiant is not sure but he does know that said Wilson was married only once and his wife was named Etta. Said Charles C. Wilson is still living in Jefferson County, Alabama, and his wife has been dead about a year and a half ago.

Said Charles Wilson procured the above and foregoing described real estate from Frank Sterrett, by deed dated September 14, 1887, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 14 at page 196.

Further deposing affiant says that he was acquainted with Louis T. Grant to whom said Charles C. Wilson deeded said land above described by deed dated November 10, 1890, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 14 at page 199, and before 1900 said Louis T. Grant left this county and has never been heard of in this section of the country. He was in some trouble and disappeared, and nobody has ever been able to find out where he went.
