

RIGHT OF WAY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the undersigned Mrs. J.F. Pope, a widow, of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars, in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits, accruing to me, and to the public from the construction of the public road through my lands, I do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors and assigns, a right of way hereinafter described over and across the lands of the undersigned in Shelby County, Alabama, for a public road, which right of way shall be ____ feet in width or ____ feet in width on each side of the center line of the said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, or as much of our lands as is required to make a ____ foot right of way, across my lands which are located and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land ~~56~~ feet in width being 33 feet in each side of the center line of State Project 330, beginning at Station 477/05 and running in a northeasterly direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 595 feet to Station 483/00. Also a strip of land 50 feet in width, being 25 feet on each side of the centerline of said survey, beginning at Station 483/00 and running in a northeasterly direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 72 feet to Station 483/72. Also a strip of land 25 feet in width lying wholly on the south side of said survey beginning at Station 483/72 and running in a northeasterly direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 63 feet to Station 484/35. Also a strip of land 33 feet in width lying wholly on the south side of said survey beginning at Station 484/35 and running in a northeasterly direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 80 feet to Station 485/15.

Also a strip of land 60 feet in width, being 33 feet in width on each side of the center line of above mentioned survey, beginning at Station 485/15 and running in a northeasterly direction along the center line of said survey for a distance of 129 feet to Station 486/44.

Also a strip of land 51 feet in width, being 18 feet in width on north side and 33 feet in width on south side of the center line of said survey, beginning at Station 486/44, and running along the center line of said survey in northeasterly direction for a distance of 121 feet to Station 487/65 and being a part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 21 south, Range 1 east, Shelby County, Alabama, and for and in consideration of the benefit to my property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective, to my property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to my property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
