 DEED OF CORRECTION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration to Pearl Flowers and husband C. L. Flowers in hand paid by L. J. Smith the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do remise release, quit claim and convey to the said L. J. Smith all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate to-wit:

An undivided one third interest in and to the following described land to-wit: The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, except 9 acres in the southeast corner of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; also the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10 acres off the eastside of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ all of said land being in Section 15, Township 21, Range 3 west, and known as the Sophia A. Faust lands; also a lot or parcel of land described as follows: Commencing at a stake at or near the top of a hill on a ditch, said ditch line being the line separating the lands of Jasper Goodson and Martha Raborn in the year 1887, thence running 70 yards due south, thence due west 40 yards to the line between J. Goodson and M. A. Raborn; thence north 70 yards, thence east 40 yards to the point of beginning, the last named land constituting one half acre and being the same land conveyed by Jasper Goodson and Martha A.
