My name is Mrs. Martha Reynolds. W. B. Reynolds was my husband and his father was H. C. Reynolds. I married Mr. W. B. Reynolds 41 years ago and have lived in Montevallo continually since our marriage.

I am familiar with the property now occupied by the storage tanks of the Brown Oil Company and particularly described in the affidavit of this date made by Mr. Rogan. There were for many years some negro houses on this part of Square 8 and Mr. Reynolds during the time he owned the property collected the rents from the negroes who occupied these houses and no one ever disputed or questioned the ownership of Mr. H. C. Reynolds. He sold this property to Mr. Rogan who occupied it and collected rents on it until he sold it to Brown Brothers and they later tore down the negro houses and built their ~~bulk~~ ^{bulk} storage plant on this property. This property is south of Shoal Creek in the Town of Montevallo Shelby County, Ala.
