KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. C. Reinhardt and wife Madora Reinhardt  
for and in consideration of Eighty & 56/100 DOLLARS,  
to U.S. paid in hand by Claudie Heaton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Claudie Heaton  
the following described property—to wit:

A parcel of land being about two acres in a V shape in the northeast corner of the  
south half of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, Section twenty two,  
Township 21, Range one east, and more particular described as follows: Beginning  
at the northeast corner of said twenty and running west 100 yards across the north  
end and thence 185 yards southeasterly to a line on the south, and being all of the  
land owned by zaid grantors on the east side of the Heaton and Jackson Public road

situated, lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama.

his heirs and assigns, forever. And We do, for ourselves and our heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant with
