## AFFIDAVIT

Before me Pauline Bird, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared T.R. Walton, who is now and has been for many years in the mercantile business in Columbiana, Alabama, who, being duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

I am familiar and know that certain lot of land situated in Columbiana, Alabama, known as the Maggie Sterrett lot, which is bounded on the south by lot of H.M. Norris on the west by L.&N. Railroad, on the north by alley on the east by lot of W.E. Morrow.

Affiant further states that along about the year 1913, W.E. Morrow, to affiant's knowledge was in possession of said lot, claiming to own the same and exercising dominion over said lot, and affiant further states that said possession was peaceable, open, notorious, adverse and continuous from said year 1913, up to and until the 17th day of June, 1914, when the said W.E. Morrow sold and conveyed a part of said lot to W.H. Sharder.

Affiant further states that the said W.H. Sharder on said 17th day of June, 1914, by virtue of said deed from W.E. Morrow and wife went into possession of the following part of said lot, to-wit:

a lot of land in the town of Columbiana, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the south line of the street leading west from the Old Court House in said town, with the east line of the right-of-way of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad, thence running east along the south line of said street 146 feet, thence south 113 feet to the lot now owned by Alice Norris, formerly belonging to H.M. Norris lot 122 feet to the east line of said railroad thence north along the east line of said railroad 143 feet to the point of beginning, and being a part of the lot formerly known as the Maggie Sterrett lot.

Affiant further states that the said W.H. Sharder took possession of said lot as aforesaid and has held and occupied the same as did W.E. Morrow before him the said 17th day of June, 1914, to and including the date of the making of this affidavit.

Affiant further states that he has at no time heard any person question or dispute the title and right of possession of the said W.E. Morrow while he owned and was in possession of said property, nor the title and right of possession of the said W.H. Sharder since he has owned and been in possession of said
