KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; that

WHEREAS, the maintrack of the railroad of Southern Railway Company running between Wilton and Valley Creek Junction crosses a branch or stream by means of a trestle about two hundred fifty (250) feet in length, the southerly end thereof beginning at a point one thousand eight hundred forty one (1841) feet north of Milepost 17-R in the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section sixteen, township twenty one south, range four west (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16, Tp. 21, S.R. 4 W) Shelby County Alabama, and

WHEREAS, the said Railway Company proposes to fill the said trestle, and for such purpose will require two (2) strips of land, one thirty (30) feet in width, on the easterly side and the other forty (40) feet in width on the westerly side of the present right of way, which is fifty (50) feet in width on each side of the center line of the said main track; that is to say, will require for the purposes of the embankment to be created in the filling of said trestle, a right of way eighty (80) feet in width on the easterly side of the center line of said main track for a distance varying from about two hundred fifty (250) feet measured along the center line of said main track to about two hundred fifty seven (257) feet measured along the line eighty (80) feet distant from and parallel with the center line of said main track, and ninety (90) feet in width on the westerly side of the center line of said main track for a distance varying from about two hundred fifty (250) feet measured along the center line of said main track, to about two hundred forty two (242) feet measured along a line ninety (90) feet distant from and parallel with the center line of said main track; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, Southern Mineral Land Company, a corporation, is the owner of said parcels of land and is willing that the said trestle may be filled, and the said embankment created thereby may extend over and beyond the limits of the present right of way and may occupy the strips or parcels of land of the undersigned hereinbefore mentioned on either side of the present right of way opposite said trestle, as aforesaid; the location of said strips or parcels of land being shown as delineated in green on the blue print map dated January 15, 1929, hereunto annexed and made a part hereof;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to it in hand paid by the grantee hereinafter named, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Southern Mineral Land Company has granted, and hereby does grant unto Southern Railway Company, and to its successors and assigns.

THE RIGHT to construct said fill in such manner that the material used therein may slope over and occupy the land of the said grantor on both sides of the present right of way for said railroad to the extent hereinbefore mentioned and recited; TOGETHER with the right to Southern Railway Company to change the said branch or stream on the said land of the grantor on both sides of said right of way in such manner that the water thereof may be conducted across the railroad and said right of way and under the said embankment by means of a thirty six (36) inch by forty (40) inch concrete culvert across said present right of way and property, to be located and constructed as shown on the said attached map.


