Thirty two (32) acres in  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 22, Tp. 22, R. 2 west, described as follows:

Commencing at NW corner of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 1, Tp. 24, R. 13 east, thence north 3 degrees and 10 minutes W. 560 yds, thence north 87 degrees and 10 minutes east 320 yards, thence south 3 degrees and 10 minutes east 550 yards to north line of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 1, Tp. 24, R. 13 east, thence south 3 degrees and 10 minutes west 320 yards to beginning point.
