

## AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA )

JEFFERSON COUNTY )

Before me the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State personally appeared Joshua M. Frost, who being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is the husband of Rebecca Cornelia Frost, and that his wife is the present owner of all that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, Township 22, Range 2 west, in Shelby County, Alabama, lying north of the Columbiana and Tuscaloosa road as now located. Affiant further says that Benjamin Frost was his great uncle and was a brother of Jessie Frost, his grand father; that Benjamin Frost disappeared during the Civil War and it was generally believed that he was killed or died during the war and that the said Benjamin Frost was unmarried and left surviving him as his only heir his brother, Jessie Frost, affiant's grandfather.

Affiant further says that Jessie Frost, conveyed to Arrenea Bragg the above described property in 1874, but there was a mistake in the deed in that it excepted twenty acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, Township 22, Range 2 west, instead of twenty acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 6. That Arrenea Bragg shortly after said property was conveyed to her took possession of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 6, built a house thereon and lived thereon until she conveyed said property to affiant's wife in 1903, the deed being recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate for Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 27, on page 146, and that the said Arrenea Bragg was an unmarried woman at the time said deed was executed and delivered. That affiant and his wife owned the property adjoining this property conveyed to them by Mrs. Bragg and on conveyance of said property to them they immediately took possession and have farmed it from the date of said deed to the present time, except a small part of it was not farmed while it was owned by E. G. Bragg, from the 18th day of April 1912 to the 13th day of December, 1912.

Affiant further says that during the time his wife owned said property, which was over twenty years, except for the short time that E. G. Bragg owned same, that no one has ever questioned the title of his wife to said property, and that his wife has been in undisputed and actual possession of said property during the time she owned same, farming said land during that time.

Affiant further says that during the time Arrenea Bragg owned said property her title to the same was never disputed and she was in actual possession of said property living on same and farming same.

Affiant further says that his uncle Jessie Frost, was unmarried during the year 1883.

Affiant further says that Solomon Evans has never made any claim to the above described property.
