Frost who being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is familiar with that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 22, Range 2 west, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, lying north of the Columbiana and Tuscaloosa road as the same now exists and has known said property since 1874 which was about the time that Arrena Bragg secured a deed to the property and took possession of same; that Arrena Bragg built a house on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW of said Section 6, and lived thereon and farmed said property until she sold said property in 1903, to Rebecca C. Frost, and that Rebecca C. Frost has been in possession of said property and farmed the same from the date she received a deed thereto until the present time except for a short period of a few months that said property was owned by E.
