

AFFIDAVIT

Before me L.H.Ellis, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, personally appeared K. B. Nickerson who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is acquainted with the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:
