NCW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and inconformity withthe several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents dogive and grant unto the said Squire. It hail and to his heirs the said tract above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereuntobelonging, unto the said Squire L Hail, and to his heirs and assigns for ever.
